Brookings-Harbor Voices PSA – Summer Activities

Hi, this is Sean Gallagher – Brookings Harbor School District 17C Superintendent here to talk to you about current summer activities for the school district. Yes, the district is on summer break from regular educational services provided for students, but there are still a myriad of activities occurring that it is important for the public to be aware of. Here are examples of those activities:

Summer School: This is available for general ed students grades 8-12 for credit recovery and academic enrichment. There is also an active ESY program for special education students. This program is being run by Mr. Buell Gonzales through July 21

Summer Foods: Any child ages 1 – 18 can come and eat both breakfast and lunch for free Mon-Thurs through August 11th. This is available for any child regardless of socio economic position. There is also a daily lunch served at Azalea Park where a lot of children are also present. Parents can eat for a nominal price also.

Summer Gardens Program: A number of students have been hired through a grant to grow produce in the two on campus gardens as an extension of school to work training. The produce is also used in the summer foods program. This allows for specific job related training for students as they prepare to transition into the workforce.

Facilities: Many projects are occurring this summer including finishing the fencing project for campus security, installing additional security cameras throughout the district, and installing additional technology in the classrooms for instructional purposes including SMARTBOARDS.

These examples are just a few of the projects occurring in addition to annual budget maintenance, school board business, hiring staff, grounds maintenance, and building cleaning. Thank you to all in the community that continue to support our schools.
