Hi, this is Sean Gallagher – Brookings Harbor School District 17C Superintendent here to talk to you about educational summer activities for kids. As the district is on summer break from regular educational services, it doesn't mean that your child should necessarily take an educational break also. Often times students lose skills over the summer months, it is important to keep those skills sharp. Here are some ideas to consider:

Online internet resources abound in practicing math skills. Simply use a popular search tool to find resources that you and your child can practice together.

Summer time is a perfect time for students to read for fun. Reading is an activity that helps students to quietly focus while practicing those reading comprehension skills. I would suggest visiting the local public library and/or book store to find books that are of interest to your child.

Summer School at BHHS is still available for general ed students grades 8-12 for credit recovery and academic enrichment. There is also an active ESY program for special education students through July 21

Summer Foods Program is available for any child ages 1 – 18 to eat both breakfast and lunch for free Mon-Thurs. This program will go through August 11th. There is even an Azalea Park lunch box service for students that frequent that area.

Also, we happen to live in a very unique area that is rich in natural sciences. Hikes along the beach or through the redwoods will expose your child to lots of natural science. Try to identify as many sea creatures and/or plants on your hike. Remember to always hike as a group, let others know where you are going and when you are expected to return, safety is always top priority.
